The project to be undertaken includes the adaptive reuse of the former Robertson Cataract Building located at 157 West Mohawk Street in the City of Buffalo. The first floor will include approximately 10,000 sq. ft. of commercial space with the remaining floors being converted into 26 loft style apartments. The facility has been vacant for more than 15 years having previously been utilized as law offices and housing a news publication stand.
