Company Description

Triad Recycling and Energy Corp. was formed in 2010. The company is a recycler of demolition debris, most notably asphalt roofing shingles used in making blacktop for road construction. The company currently supplies recycled materials to LaFarge North America and Niagara Metals.

Project Description

The proposed project involves the acquisition and redevelopment of the project site as a recycling center for construction materials. There are 3 existing building totaling 19,186 sq. ft. which have been vacant or under utilized for several years It is anticipated that up to 95% of the materials that will be handled will be converted into recycled products. The company currently operates a similar facility in Maryland. Equipment currently utilized in Maryland will be moved to the Tonawanda site.

The company's application states that the NYS DEC have encouraged them to form this operation in New York State and are in the process of processing Triad's permit application.
