The buildings on this site are in extreme disrepair and imminent collapse, so much so that we have already had to expend \$150,000.00 to stabilize and reinforce the existing exterior walls to keep the building stable. The buildings have been unoccupied

since the late 90's and after being sold to a not-for-profit organization, were allowed to deteriorate into the current condition.

The project will utilize the State and Federal Historic Tax Credits to adaptively convert the buildings into 18 Affordable Apartments, Offices for NAACP, Offices for Legislator Barbara Miller Williams, a Full Service Restaurant and 1,800sf of available space for another commercial tenant. This funding will make it possible to restore and adaptively re-use a group of strategically located buildings which have been unoccupied since the early two thousands. the buildings have been rapidly advancing to infeasibility.

Also, the project budget includes almost three quarters of a million dollars specifically designated to restore, rebuild and repair the collapsing structure in order to safe it. The benefits offered by the ECIDA will have a profound effect on our success.
