The proposed project (the "Project") consists of: (i) a parcel of land located at 3101 Broadway, Town of Cheektowaga, Erie County, New York (the "Land") to be improved thereon with a new 3,000+/- SF cooling tower; a new 1,600+/- SF addition to the existing substation to allow an additional feed line to their 6,500 hp test stand; and the renovation, upgrading and equipping of existing space to provide infrastructure for future expansion (the "Improvements"), and (ii) the

acquisition and installation by the Company of certain items of machinery, equipment and other tangible personal property (the "Equipment," and collectively with the Land and the Improvements, the "Facility").

The proposed financial assistance contemplated by the Agency includes New York State and local sales and use tax exemption benefits (in compliance with Agency's uniform tax exemption policy).

We want to support them as much as we can. Hopefully they will stay within the Town borders and I want the IDA to support this project as well.
