We do mainly collections on past due student loans. The project is at Como Park over at Apple Tree. We are currently at another location and have about 12,000 sq. ft. and we have outgrown that facility. We are looking at this new facility; it's about 25,000 sq. ft. We have a lot of employees within the space so we have a requirement of about 10 parking spots per 1,000 sq. ft. Our current location is unable to meet that objective as we are going forward so that's why we started looking for the new space and this location at Apple Tree Office Park is able to provide us that parking as well as the square footage that we needed; the 25,000 sq. ft. This project is really to enable us to grow further in the Buffalo area. We are going to be building out the entire facility. We're going to have all new furniture that we are going to be bringing in. We are going to have a server room; it's going to be our backup to our main facilities back in Fairport so we're going to have a bunch of servers. We also have computers for every single employee; we are going to be replacing all of those computers for the employees coming in so we are expecting it to be about 1.4 million dollars in furniture and equipment that we will be spending on that.

Mary Holtz, Town of Cheektowaga Supervisor. I support this project and I've already sent in a letter of support. I understand that Town of Lancaster has agreed to this move, no problem there. Also the fact that we are filling some back offices in the Apple Tree Mall that have moved to the City of Buffalo which is also positive, plus the jobs are well paying so they are going to increase the number of jobs so I am completely in support of this project.
