<u>Hearing Officer</u>: Welcome. This public hearing is now open; it is 9:00 a.m. My name is Karen Fiala. I am the Manager of Tax Incentives of the Erie County Industrial Development Agency, and I have been designated by the Agency to be the hearing officer to conduct this public hearing.

2. PURPOSE: Purpose of the Hearing.

<u>Hearing Officer</u>: We are here to hold the public hearing on the 3755 River Road LLC and/or Individual(s) or Affiliate(s), Subsidiary(ies), or Entity(ies) formed or to be formed on its behalf project. The transcript of this hearing will be reviewed and considered by the Agency in determination of this project. Notice of this hearing appeared in <u>The Buffalo News</u> on December 12, 2015.

3. PROJECT SUMMARY: Description of Project and Contemplated Agency Benefits.

<u>Hearing Officer</u>: The proposed project (the "Project") consists of: (i) a 15+/- acre parcel of land located at 3703 River Road, Town of Tonawanda, Erie County, New York (the "Land"), improved with two (2) existing buildings (the "Existing Improvements"), (ii) infrastructure improvements to the Land including a wind turbine to generate electricity for the Project; expansion, renovation and upgrading of the Existing Improvements; and the construction of a 4,000+/- SF processing building (the "Improvements"); and (iii) the acquisition and installation of certain machinery, equipment and items of personal property thereon (the "Equipment" and, collectively with the Land, the Existing Improvements, and Improvements, the "Facility").

The proposed financial assistance contemplated by the Agency includes New York State and local sales and use tax exemption benefits, mortgage recording tax exemption benefits, and real property tax abatement benefits (in compliance with Agency's uniform tax exemption policy).

John Hannon – Triad Recycling & Energy – This purchase of 15 acres and expansion is an actual expansion of our 8 acre facility where we are recycling thousands of tons of construction debris formerly going into a landfill. We envision the project in four phases where we are able to do the project economically, add employees and make improvements to the site. We will continue to work very closely with the Town Building Department and the Department of Environment & Conservation to figure out how to do each one of these streams. And it's significant that we have been the first one in New York State to recycle successfully a number of materials. One of the phases in the expansion is actually a public drop off area. We found many people would like to recycle, but there are no facilities in Erie County. We think we are a good part of the community and we are very encouraged that Erie County supports this project.
