8 Dona Street is a planned 150,000 sq. ft., single story industrial building featuring 36 ft. clear height and generous column spacing to serve as a hub for manufacturing, warehousing, logistics, and trucking operations. The facility has opportunities for single or multiple tenants with customized office build-out.

Join the company of TMP Technologies & Sucro Sourcing

TMP Technologies purchased a 28-acre parcel and constructed a 280,000 sq. ft. manufacturing facility in 2021.

Sucro Sourcing is investing \$19 million to transform three abandoned buildings over a 12-acre space into newly refurbished facilities. The project will be completed in phases and completed fully by 2024.



Strategic Location

Located minutes from the Canadian-American border, the region is within 500 miles of 40% of the continental North American population. Renaissance Commerce Park is just 5.5 miles from interstate 190, 6.5 miles from downtown Buffalo, 105 miles to Toronto, and 187 miles to Cleveland.

International Bridge

Renaissance Commerce Park is seven minutes from the Peace Bridge. (One of four US-Canada bridges)



Rail

Access to four Class I rail lines (CSX Transportation, Norfolk Southern, Canadian Pacific Railway, and Canadian National Railway)



Port

Adjacent to deep-water port access at the Port of Buffalo, the first major U.S. Port Call encountered when entering the Great Lakes. Located on two hundred acres, the Port consists of 28 terminals, and features a 230-ton American crawler crane.



Air

Renaissance Commerce Park is 12 miles from the Buffalo-Niagara international Airport.
