Steve Zenger is President and CEO of Zenger Group Inc., a family-owned collection of 3 printing and graphic arts companies based in Buffalo, New York.

Zenger Group along with divisions Partners Press and Downtown Graphics provide one-stop access to a broad range of print services from Advanced Data and Prepress to Packaging, Print and Mail. The company, employing 110 full-time staff, serves clients nationwide.

Mr. Zenger is a past Chairman of the Printing Industries Alliance, the New York/Northern New Jersey affiliate of the then Printing Industries of America trade association. He had served as a board director from 1995 to 2010.

Throughout his career, Steve has served on numerous other national, local and regional printing industry association and education boards.

In addition, he has served on the board of directors and executive committee of the Buffalo Niagara Partnership since 2006 and as a Trustee of Daemen University in Amherst, NY since 2019. Steve served on the board of WEDI, a non-profit inner-city business incubator on the West Side of Buffalo from 2016 thru 2025 including 4 years as Board President.

He is a graduate of Canisius High School and holds a Bachelor of Arts degree in communications from the State University of New York College at Buffalo.

Mr. Zenger was the 1995 recipient of the Alex Osborne Communicator of the Year Award from the Art Directors/Communicators of Buffalo, was awarded the Honoring Excellence Member of the Year by the Buffalo Niagara Partnership in 2007 and was a 2018 recipient of a Buffalo Business First C-Level Award. In 2016, Steve was awarded a national printing industry Luminaire Award for excellence and service to the field of graphic communications. Printing Impressions and Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT) selected Steve for induction into the national 2021 class of the Printing Industry Hall of Fame.
