PROJECTS

<u>Clearview Social Inc., 77 Goodell Street, Buffalo, New York, \$300,000 87-Month working capital loan, secured and guaranteed.</u> Mr. Alexander presented the application and the loan case. General discussion ensued. Ms. LaTulip moved and Mr. Taylor seconded to approve of the loan request. The motion was then unanimously approved.

Port O'Call Brewing Co., 43 Marquette Avenue, Kenmore, New York, \$215,000 7-Year term loan, secured and guaranteed. Mr. Alexander presented the application and the loan case. General discussion ensued and concern was expressed over the sufficiency of the collateral and a desire to obtain additional collateral was expressed. At this point in time, Mr. Alexander stated that he would ask the applicant to identify additional collateral sources and/or additional guarantors and thereafter report back to the Committee to confirm and discuss collateral issues. Mr. Emminger then tabled the action to be presented to the Committee at the next Loan Committee meeting for consideration of Mr. Alexander's report.
